TOURNAMENT DETAILS

The tournament will be held over **3 days** at the Sir David Wallace (SDW) Sports Arena, Netball Centre and Victory Hall (6 indoor courts).

- **Day 1**: Tournament briefing 9:00am Games start 9:30am
- Day 2: Court access 8:30am Games start 8:50am
- **Day 3**: Finals day. Games start 9:00am Div 1 finals played on SDW show court

Spectator tickets for Sunday's finals will go on sale July 1st. Awards follow the Div 1 Grand Finals on show court.

TOURNAMENT REQUIREMENTS

All players must have purchased 2024 EMMNA membership on ENgage. Clubs must be linked to EMMNA on ENgage: <u>engage.englandnetball.co.uk</u>

- Maximum of 12 players per men's team
- Maximum of 14 players per mixed team
- Maximum of 5 support staff on bench
- Maximum of 3 teams per club
- Players can only play for 1 team
- Teams are required to have matching playing kit & bibs
- All teams must abide by the EMMNA Code of Conduct
- All deadlines must be adhered to

OFFICIATING AND RULES





EMMNA will provide England Netball qualified umpires with a minimum of B Award, including internationally accredited umpires.

EMMNA will also provide England Netball qualified bench officials for Div 1 & 2 finals.

Please note, the updated World Netball rules & regulations (January 2024) will apply. A briefing on rule updates will be shared with all teams prior to the tournament. All players will need to confirm they have watched the training videos.

Mixed Teams:

- Minimum of 2 non-female players on court at all times
- Maximum of 3 non-female players on court at any one time
- Maximum of 1 non-female allowed in each third (attack, midcourt, defence)
- EMMNA recognises a player's right to selfidentify their gender

The EMMNA Code of Conduct must be read and agreed to by all players prior to the tournament.

ENTRY FEES AND DEPOSIT

Men's Team Entry: £720 per team

Mixed Team Entry: £840 per team

 31st March Deposits are £150 per team*
- Balance payments & player registrations due **30th June**

- Team spaces are limited
- EMMNA League teams have priority entry
- International teams have invitational entry
- Deposit is refundable if tournament oversubscribed
- EMMNA decision on team entry is final
- Deadlines will be strictly enforced.
- Deposits will NOT be refunded if deadlines are missed
